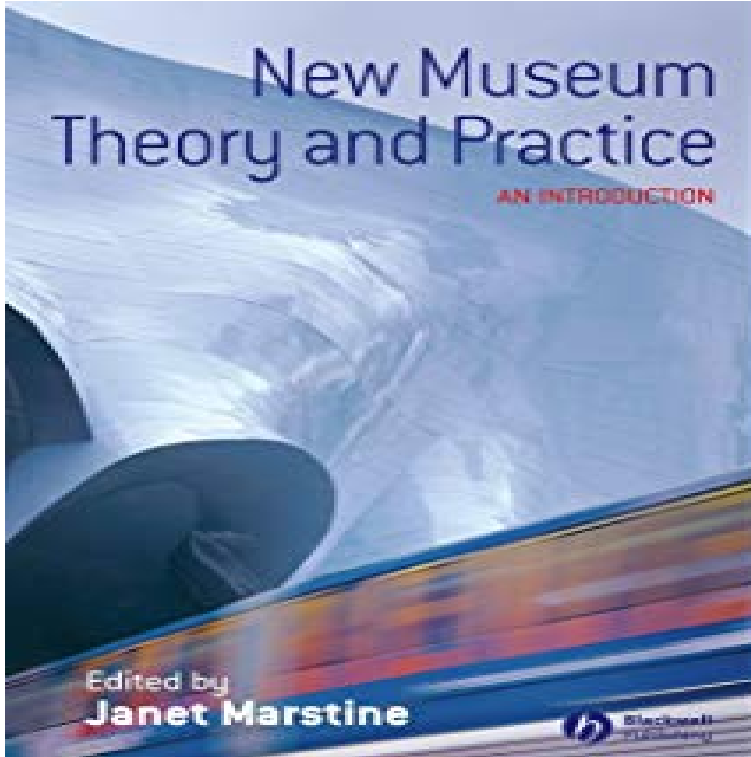


# Museums And Source Communities: A Routledge Reader
