

# Gender, War And Politics: Transatlantic Perspectives, 1775-1830

**STATEMENT OF SELECTIVE SERVICE REGISTRATION STATUS**

If you are a male age 18 through 25, federal law requires that you must be registered with the U.S. Selective Service System, unless you meet certain exemptions under Selective Service law. Under HB 558, enacted by the 76<sup>th</sup> Texas State Legislature, if you are currently of the age and gender requiring registration with Selective Service, but knowingly and willfully fail to do so, you are ineligible for employment with an agency in any branch of Texas state government. I understand that any false statements may void my application for employment and that the information provided on this form will be used only for evaluation of eligibility for employment.
