

Writing Saskatchewan: 20 Critical Essays

COMMON ESSAY DIRECTIVE WORDS EXPLAINED

Analyse	Identify and examine its key elements, their strengths and weaknesses and the relationship between them.
Assess	Decide to what extent something is useful, valuable or true. Identify strengths and weaknesses and come to a logical decision.
Compare OR Contrast	Identify and explain the similarities (or differences) between two or more concepts, ideas, theorists. Decide if some are stronger or more important. You may also be expected to explain the alternative.
Compare + Contrast	Identify and explain the similarities and differences between two or more concepts, ideas, theorists. Decide if some are stronger or more important. If appropriate, make a choice and justify.
Critically Assess/ Evaluate	Gather and weigh up the evidence for and against something. Come to a final conclusion after reasoned judgement.
Define	Give the precise meaning of a term or idea. You may have to consider different definitions or interpretations and outline any issues in defining the meaning.
Describe	Identify and provide a detailed explanation of something. This could include its features or answering questions like what, how and why?
Discuss	Present both sides or pros and cons; elaborate and build a case for each then come to a conclusion.
Evaluate	Same as critically evaluate/assess.
Examine	Consider and investigate the key features, issues and facts of a topic. May need to include critique and determine which ideas are the most important.
Explain	Detail the what, why, when and how of an issue. Outline and describe its key features, causes, process or timeline.
Explore	Identify and discuss different perspectives of an idea or issue. Evaluate these perspectives and form a reasoned final argument.
Illustrate	Similar to explain but include examples, evidence or statistics to answer the question.
Justify	Present an argument and support with a body of evidence. Explain decision making process and possible objections. Include balance by considering alternative viewpoints.
Outline	Give the main points and essential details in an organised manner, omitting minor points.
Review	Describe and explain the main points of the subject/issue. Ensure you include critical examination and assessment not just description.
Summarise	condense and present the main facts, ideas, strengths and limitations. Leave out details and elaboration.
